

**NOTICE OF ELECTION AND  
REQUEST TO SUBMIT ARGUMENTS “FOR” OR “AGAINST”  
THE PERMANENT BASE EXPENDITURE LIMIT ADJUSTMENT BALLOT  
PROPOSITION**

**PIMA COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA**

Pima County Community College District of Pima County, Arizona (the “*District*”), will hold a special election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 seeking authorization to adjust the base expenditure limit adopted for the District in fiscal year 1979-80. If approved, the base expenditure limit of the District will be permanently adjusted by \$11,484,199.

The last day to register to vote in order to be eligible to vote in this election is Monday, October 5, 2020.

The District will give notice of the election by mailing an informational pamphlet to households in Pima County with a registered voter. The pamphlet will include the full text of the question that will appear on the ballot, as well as an analysis of the requested change and arguments “for” and “against” the question to be decided by the election. The full text of the question to be considered at the election and the [District Governing Board resolution](#) calling for the election are available at the District, 4905 E. Broadway Blvd., Tucson, Arizona 85709, and on the District’s website. Any person interested in providing an argument either “for” or “against” the ballot measure is hereby requested to provide the argument to the District, on or before 5:00 p.m., August 5, 2020.

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes, each argument filed shall not exceed 300 words and shall be signed by each person sponsoring it; if the argument is sponsored by an organization, it shall contain the signatures of two executive officers of the organization or if sponsored by a political committee it shall contain the signature of the committee’s chairman or treasurer. Each argument filed shall also be submitted in electronic format to the District’s General Counsel at [jsilvyn@pima.edu](mailto:jsilvyn@pima.edu). The person or persons signing the argument shall identify themselves by giving their residence or post office address and a telephone number. This contact information shall not appear in the informational pamphlet.
